MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING

Between

English Language Teachers' Association of India
ELTAI Thoothukudi (Annammal College of Education) Chapter

And

Annai Hajira Women's College, Melapalayam

PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into by **English Language Teachers' Association of India (Thoothukudi Chapter)** hereafter 'ELTAI Thoothukudi Chapter', and between **Annai Hajira Women's College, Melapalayam** hereafter AHWC and are referred to collectively, as "Parties" or individually as "Party."

1. Purpose

It is a matter of grave concern that the generation of today has strayed away from the collaborative culture. By participating in a competition organized by institutions and academic associations, they have a **new opportunity to show their talent and apply their skills individually or collaboratively**. In turn, the rewards of student competitions, whether tangible or otherwise, can help them to achieve their

educational and professional goals. Hence, the primary purpose is to motivate and prepare the students for **Healthy competition** which inspires kids to do their best. Also, to conduct the following (selected) **Skills Development Programmes** for students to get them ready for the job market:

- Critical Thinking
- Creative Writing
- Problem Solving
- And other 21 Century Skills

Teacher Training Programmes that enhance and empower knowledge, skills and expertise as a teacher for their professional growth and development. This would help them to learn the knowledge and attitudes they need to be a teacher in an educational setting.

The purpose of this MoU is to define the roles and responsibilities for driving in conducting these events annually in which the Parties desire to work together for helping to develop students' healthy competitive spirits and skills development and teachers for their professional growth.

2. Scope

This MoU sets forth the intentions of the Parties for increased collaboration, cooperation and interaction and does not create any legally binding commitments.

3. The Parties intend to:

- conduct District/State/National Level **competitions annually** for Arts and Science students in their areas of interests and need.
- organize **skills development and teacher development and training** programmes for students and teachers
- encourage collaboration and cooperation of projects related to **student and faculty development** from the user communities associated with each Party.
- encourage young learners to read to lead by establishing reading club in the college

4. Confidentiality

The parties agree that there is no intention to share any confidential or proprietary information in any collaboration under this MoU. If either Party wishes to disclose information it considers to be confidential or proprietary to the other Party, the Parties will enter into a written non-disclosure agreement. It is also understood and agreed that no information will be exchanged or disseminated under any collaborations pursuant to this MoU which is not as per laws of government and its relevant legislations.

5. Roles and Responsibilities

Annai Hajira Women's College, Melapalayam

1. The college to become a long-term Member of ELTAI
2. To provide space with proper seating arrangements for students and resource persons from inside and outside the campus to meet regularly

3. The role of the 2 staff-in-charge to plan and coordinate well with the Chapter Head for the project to succeed
4. To meet partial remuneration of resource persons sent by ELTAI for the workshops, if any, conducted by ELTAI for teachers of the college, besides providing them with free accommodation and local hospitality.
5. To provide assistance in organizing any event on virtual platform.
6. Inaugurate a Reading Movement for the students and submitting the activities of it to the chapter
7. To depute at least two teachers to attend our ELTAI Thoothukudi Chapter events
8. Second Language teachers of the college should become the members of ELTAI with 10% waive in the subscription fee.

ELTAI Thoothukudi Chapter

1. To make use of the human and material resources of the college (ACE)
2. ELTAI Thoothukudi Chapter to sponsor prizes for the conduct of District/State/National Level inter-collegiate competitions every year and one intra-collegiate competitions.
3. Deputing resource persons for conducting teacher training programmes
4. To meet partial remuneration of resource persons sent by ELTAI for the workshops, if any, conducted by ELTAI for teachers of the college
5. To accommodate college children in the college premises for project-based learning (PBL) and Task based learning (TBL) activities.
6. To waive 50% of the registration fee of two deputed members of faculty from the college for the ELTAI Chapter events
7. To waive registration fee for the college (AHWC) children to participate in the competitions organized by the college (ACE)

6. Duration

This MoU shall be effective for a period of Five (5) years from the date of final signature. It may be modified or extended by mutual written agreement by the Parties. This MoU may be terminated by either party upon six (6) months advance written notice.
