MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

ANNAI HAJIRA WOMEN'S COLLEGE, TIRUNELVELI.

This Memorandum of Understanding is made and effective as on 22-04-2022.

PARTIES OF THE AGREEMENT

This agreement is made by and between
ANNAI HAJIRA WOMEN'S COLLEGE
Melapalayam, Tirunelveli - 627005.
(herein referred to as the first party)

And

EKALAI ACADEMY
5/28 G, Kavitha Nagar, Angeripalayam, Tiruppur-641603.
(herein referred to as the second party)

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

PURPOSE OF THE MoU

The purpose of this MoU is to set up a mutual collaboration between the two parties of agreement for the motive of implementing a certification course. This agreement establishes the scope of operations between the two parties of agreement and commits to writing the mutual assent of both parties to engage in the agreed activities, subject to the terms and conditions agreed upon by both the parties.

In particular, this MOU is intended to

1. Enhance entrepreneurial mindsets among the students of Entrepreneurship Development certificate course.
2. Organize various workshops on Entrepreneurship Development.
3. Conduct practical trainings on Entrepreneurship Development.
4. Assist the students in establishing various start-ups.

1. CO-OPERATION

1.1 Both parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations. The parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

1.2 The co-operation between First Party and Second Party will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the Second Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/ training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the First Party.

2. SCOPE OF THE MOU

2.1 Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be a major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

2.2 The Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching/ training methodology so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.

2.3 The Second Party will train the students and faculties of the First Party on the entrepreneurship and business administration in order to bridge the gap in skill and make them for aspiring entrepreneurs.

2.4 The Second Party will extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students of the First Party.

2.5 This document sets out the basic terms upon which the Parties would be prepared to enter into a binding agreement with each other in order to use their respective skills, knowledge and assets for mutual benefit in a joint project consisting of:

- a) Sharing resources for achieving mutual goals
- b) Knowledge and name sharing
- c) Support for advanced courses
- d) Organizing workshop, conference, webinars & etc.
- e) Implementation of various programs

3. TERM OF THE MoU

The term of this agreement shall be for a period of 3 years commencing as of the date of this agreement. Each year of the term as measured from the date of this agreement is a "Contract year".

4. MUTUAL UNDERSTANDINGS

It is mutually agreed upon and understood by and among the Parties that:

- a) The Parties agree to work together and co-operate in good faith and to fully participate to develop the project.
- b) This agreement in no way restricts the ability of either party to enter into any agreement with any other third party in relation to either the proposed Project or any other proposed project of a similar nature.

5. CONFLICTS & DISPUTE RESOLUTION

The Parties will attempt in good faith to resolve any dispute arising out of or in relation to this document or the negotiation of the Formal Agreement through negotiations between an appointed person of each party with authority to settle the relevant dispute. If the dispute cannot be settled amicably within 7 days from the date on which either Party has served written notice on the other of the dispute then neither Party shall be obligated to enter into the Formal Agreement.

For smooth and efficient functioning and implementation of the MoU, both the parties shall meet at regular intervals on mutually agreed dates and review the program / progress, also take action to remove the difficulties / constraints if any in implementing the MoU.

6. GOVERNING LAW

The provisions of this agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Tamil Nadu.
