#### Methodology

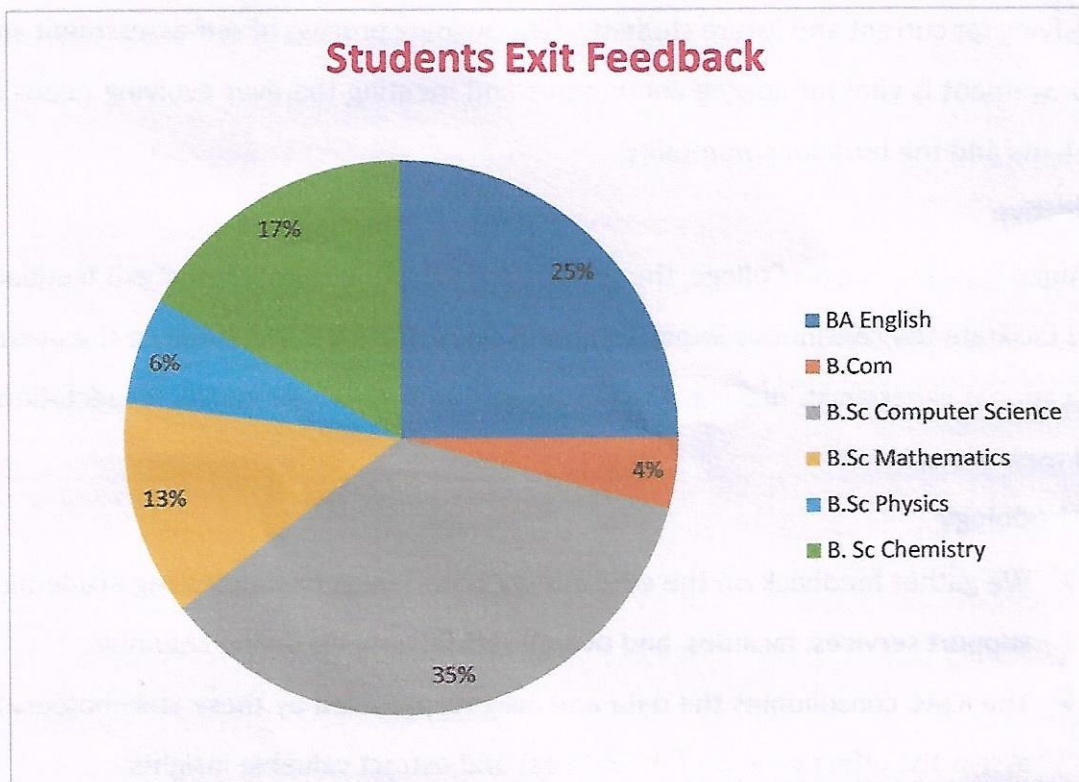
- We gather feedback on the educational experience, encompassing academics, support services, facilities, and overall satisfaction, via online channels.

## Students Exit Feedback - Percentage Analysis 2023 - 2024

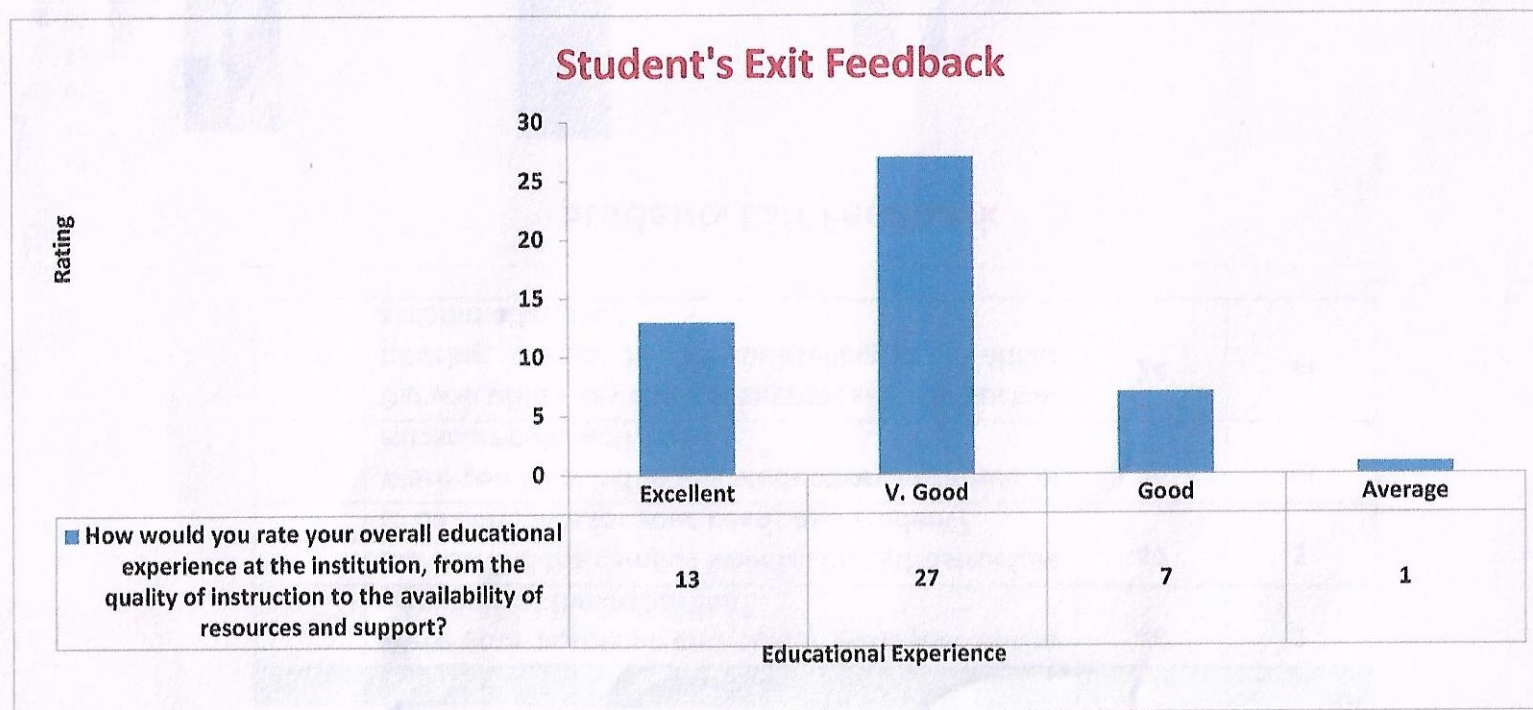

The feedback encompasses a five-point rating scale and the impartially shared opinions of students, all of which offer insights into their experiences with the ambience.

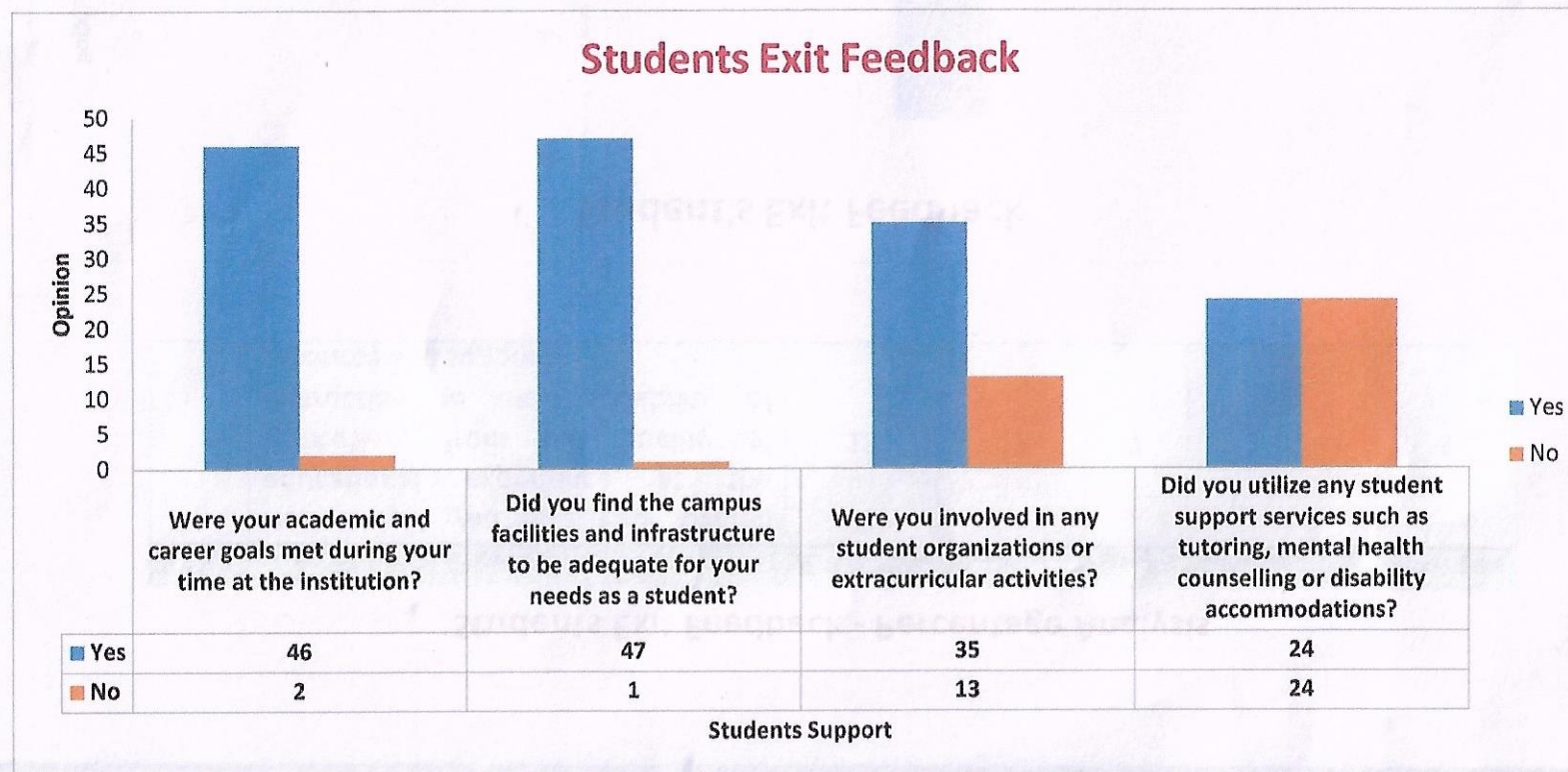
